

## Project Gros Mangles Year-End Report 2021

This report includes gifts made to the Project Gros Mangles 501(c)(3) charity between January 1 and December 31, 2021.

Thank you, everyone! Project Gros Mangles had a great first year, considering the many challenges that 2021 threw in: the continued effects of the pandemic, the increased instability brought on by the assassination of President Jovenel Moïse, the August 14 earthquake and the violence and threats that have reached La Gonâve, with Dr. Rony being victim of an attack in mid-December. Nonetheless, the Centre de Santé Belval de Gros-Mangles continued to fulfill its mission. They cared for more patients than in the first 6 months of the opening, with a spike right after the earthquake as patients were forced to cross the gulf to access medical resources in La Gonâve.

### A. Our Progress



On June 1, 2020 the Centre de Santé Belval de Gros-Mangles (CSBGM) opened its doors under the direction of Dr. Jeune Jean Rony, who recruited an amazing team of vibrant health care practitioners, gathered the necessary supplies and equipment, and spearheaded the effort to get the medical facility ready to see patients – all within a 10-month timeframe.

Dr. Agnès Belval Ragone's vision was finally becoming a reality after 7 years of hard work. The center has since been treating patients within a two-hour radius of Gros-Mangles, to the immense satisfaction of the local population. 2021 marked the first full year of operation of CSBGM. In August 2021, after the latest

earthquake devastated the island, Dr. Rony and his team were well positioned to provide aid to victims. They even saw patients who made the trip from the main island to seek care. In addition, the community has been facing food, medication and medical shortages due to the political upheaval, all the while battling the Covid-19 pandemic. At the moment, the team of 5 works 24/7 to provide the care needed. We have also been able to help the community with food. Of course, none of this would be possible without the support of our incredible donors

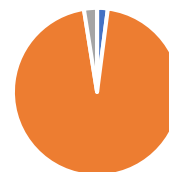
